Using the Lift

Emergency Stop Activation Press down on red button to activate.

Room to room transfers

Activate desired belt by turning

directional lever. If lever faces

towards the leg hook, the belt

nearest to the leg hook is active. If it

faces towards the hanger bar, the belt

closest to the hanger bar is active.

Emergency De-Activation Turn red button clockwise.

Important! Emergency lowering must only be used in \wedge emergency situations. There will be a 3 second delay.

Important! Do not turn the lever unless both belts are connected to their respective rail rollers. The

lever must always point to the connected belt.

Room to Room Transfer Feature



Suspending the lift Place the lift on a suitable surface

and feed out belt by gently pulling out belt while at the same time pressing the "Down" button on either the hand control or

secondary panel. Hook lift belt onto distance strap so that it is held firmly in position (easiest to hook from above at an angle as shown). Ensure the lift belt is firmly in place before use.





Attach head sling loops to hanger bar first, then leg straps to leg hooks. Ensure the straps are secured beneath the safety pin.

Proper lifting techniques

Do not use the hanger bar to move the patient and the lift. Do not hold onto the hooks while performing a lift. Once the patient is comfortably secured in sling, raise lift, hold sling and position/move patient.

General Care

Never use strong

detergents on lift.

Disinfect with DuPont™ Virkon®.

Do not immerse in water.

Activate emergency stop when not in use

Important! Use only authorized methods to

transport! Lift must always be stored or moved in horizontal position. Rest on cart to move or use approved carru strap¹

¹ Caution! When using strap, extra caution must be taken not to wrinkle or bend the lift belt.

Inspection

Annual Inspection - The lift must be inspected at least once per year by a gualified technician certified by Human Care. Replace lift belt at a minimum every second year as a preventative action.

Monthly Inspection - Check lift belts for damage or wear. Feed entire length to ensure proper functioning.

Daily Inspection - Always inspect the lift for visible signs of damage before use. Ensure the lift is correctly mounted on the distance strap or rail roller. Always check slings and belts for signs of wear before use. Do not use if wear evident.

Troubleshooting

 \bigcirc If the indicator light is not on, check the following: - Mains switch is on - Batteries are fully discharged - charge or replace - Emergency stop button is not pushed in (deactivate by turning clockwise)

If the indicator light is flashing, check the following:

- Hand control button does not function up/down when depressed (replace if necessaru) - When pressing up, the lift is not already in its maximum upper position (lower with down button) - When pressing down, the lift is not already in its maximum lower position (raise with up button)



- The lift is overloaded - lower using emergencu lowering button If the indicator light is constant yellow:



If the lift belt does not feed out properly: - Pull the belt upwards at the same time as you depress the down button on the hand control / lift panel
